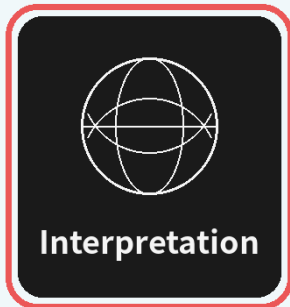


How to Listen with Zoom Interpretation



For Strawberry Jam Participants

The main audio is English, with interpretation channels in Japanese, Korean, and Chinese. If English works for you, you don't need to select anything.



Look for this globe icon!

Click / Tap

Click it and pick a language — that's it.

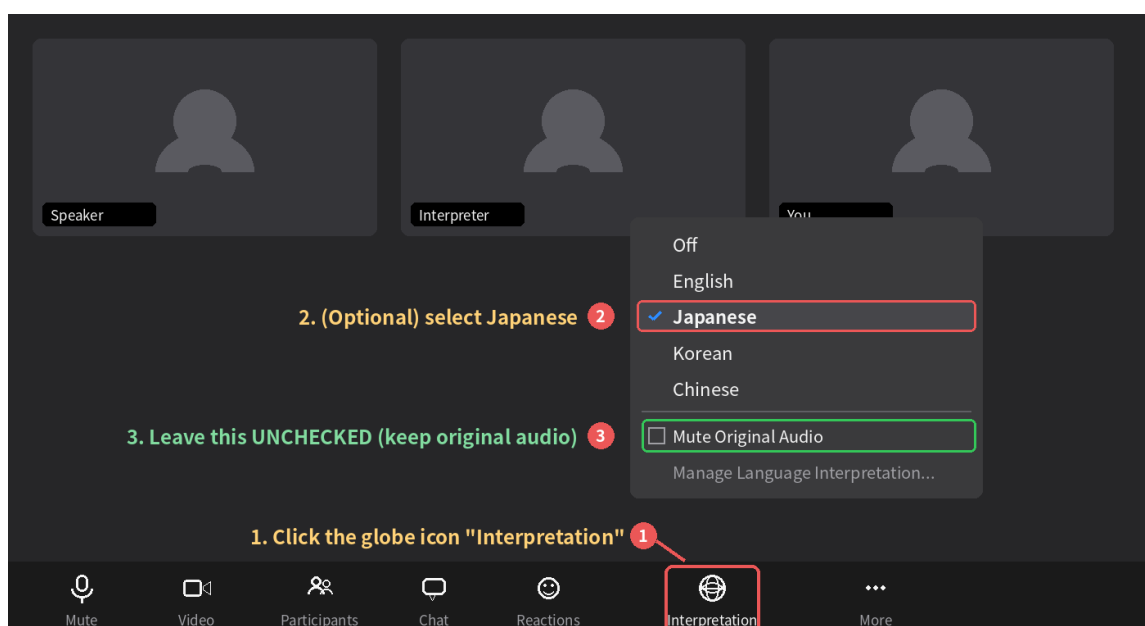
★ Good to know: quiet pauses are normal

We use consecutive interpretation: the interpreters speak after the speaker finishes, so the main audio goes quiet for a moment — nothing is wrong. If you'd like something to listen to during the pauses, feel free to select the Japanese channel (optional). Either way, please do not turn on "Mute Original Audio".

■ On a computer (Windows / Mac) — optional

1. Click the globe icon "Interpretation" in the toolbar at the bottom
2. Select "Japanese" (optional — skip if you only want English)
3. Leave "Mute Original Audio" unchecked

※ On a computer, the globe icon may not appear in the toolbar. If so, click "... More" on the far right — you'll find "Interpretation" inside.



■ On a phone / tablet (iPhone / Android) — optional

1. Tap "... More" at the bottom right
2. Tap "Language Interpretation"
3. Select "Japanese" (optional)
4. Leave the "Mute Original Audio" switch OFF
5. Tap "Done"
